



News From The Octagon Barn Center Project

Just Looking Gallery in downtown San Luis Obispo now has a special limited-edition poster for sale, featuring the Octagon Barn and the Bob Jones Trail. The piece is by the renowned poster artist, **Steve Thomas** who, as a freelance illustrator, worked with Disney, Lucasfilm, Marvel, The Muppets, Hasbro and Star Trek. Heavily influenced by the Golden Age of Illustration, Steve Thomas' vintage 1930's style posters capture the beauty and unique nature of California's Central Coast. In the case of the Octagon Barn image, Steve has captured a bit of the past with the Barn and a bit of the future, when the Barn anchors a major hub in the city and county trail system.

Gallery owner Ralph Gorton commissioned this piece specifically to honor the work of his close friend and environmentalist icon Bob Jones and to help the Land Conservancy of San Luis Obispo in its fundraising for the **Pismo Preserve** project. Proceeds from the sales of the posters will help close the remaining funding gap (currently, approximately \$600K).
