Conservation Project Manager

The **Conservation Project Manager** plays a critical role in The Land Conservancy's acquisition of new conservation lands and stewardship of existing protected lands. This role is responsible for land conservation acquisition project development, monitoring conservation easements and fee-owned protected lands, grant writing and project funding management, conservation easement drafting, baseline documentation reports, fee land stewardship plans, and maintaining landowner relationships. This position will offer opportunities for personal and professional development and is a great opportunity to join a respected organization working on interesting and exciting projects.

The Conservation Project Manager will report directly to the Conservation Director and work closely with the Land Department and Deputy Director. This is a full-time, non-exempt (40 hours/week) ongoing position. Starting compensation ranges from \$29 to \$33/hour, depending on experience. A competitive benefits package includes health insurance, 401K plan with company match, 21 days Paid Time Off (PTO), 12 paid holidays, dental and vision plans, and a flexible work environment with opportunities for hybrid in office / remote work.
